



Dishwashing Machine Operation

All dishwashing machines should be operated according to the recommendations provided by their manufacturers.


Most tableware, utensils, and pots and pans should be cleaned and sanitized in either a *high-temperature dishwashing machine* that uses hot water or a *chemical-sanitizing dishwashing machine* that uses a chemical sanitizing solution. No matter the type of machine, some general procedures must be followed.




- 1 Check the machine for cleanliness at least once a day, cleaning it as necessary. Fill tanks with clean water, clear food and debris from spray nozzles, and fill detergent and sanitizer dispensers properly.



- 2 Scrape, rinse, or soak items before washing. Presoak items having dried-on food.




- 3 Load dish racks correctly. Make sure all surfaces are exposed to the spray action of the dishwasher. Don't overload racks.



- 4 Check temperatures and pressure. Follow the manufacturer's recommendations.



- 5 Check each rack as it comes out of the machine for soiled items. Run dirty items through again until they are clean.



- 6 Air-dry all items. Place glasses, cups, pots and pans upside down on the drying rack. Place flatware and utensils with handles up.
